


Homework –Year 1 and Year 2 Spring Term: Out Of This World

The Out of This World Homework grid below contains extra activities which can be completed and handed in at any time during the Spring Term, which ends on Friday 12th February.

You may choose to complete some or all of the activities.

This is in addition to reading with your child as often as possible and weekly homework, which will consist of spellings in Year 2 and Phonics in Year 1.

Borrow a space story or information book from the library. Share it with your family or bring it to school.	Read every day. Practise your number bonds (pairs to 10, 20) and times tables everyday.	Imagine you are going to visit another planet, like the bear in 'Whatever Next!'. Make a rocket model which could take you there, using old cardboard boxes, bottles and yoghurt pots.
Create your own alien picture, using paint, paper and fabric.		What can you find out about space? Research the solar system: How many planets are there? What are they all called?
Design your own alien and label it. Write about what it looks like, what it eats and where it lives.	Make a list of ten things you would take on a trip to the moon.	Share what you know about space with your family.
