Observational drawings of trees and woodland animals.

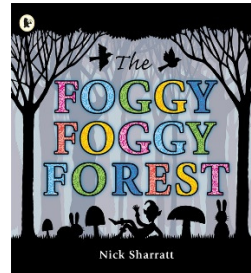
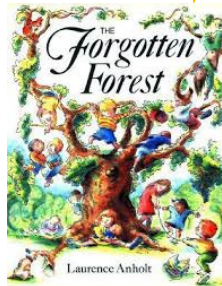
Create an Autumn tree picture using materials collected for the woods.
