Building Learning Power (BLP)

As a school we believe that children should understand the type of characteristic that they need to have in order to become fantastic learners. In order to do this we use "Building Learning Power". During the year pupils will be focussing on the following characteristics:

Foundation Stage:

Collaboration, Perseverance, Managing Distractions
Imagining, Planning, Listening and Empathy

Year 1 will focus on all of the above plus:

Interdependence, Absorption, Questioning and Planning

Year 2, all of the above plus:

Capitalising, Noticing, Reasoning, Meta-learning (learning about how to learn) and Imitation

Years 3-6

All of the above

We slowly drip the characteristics into lessons over the year and monitor the traits that pupils display so that we can focus on areas in which pupils may not be as strong. Over the past year BLP has made a huge difference to the learning behaviours of the children and we are looking forward to seeing these develop further again this year.
